

Understanding your result GESE Conversion tables

Graded Examinations in Spoken English

You can use the conversion tables below to check what overall result a candidate will receive from their combination of letter grades awarded for each of the exam phases. For example, at Intermediate stage (Grades 7-9) a result of ABC = Pass with merit.

NB The letter grades can be awarded in any order, because all phases of the exam have equal weighting. Thus, using the example above; ABC, ACB, BAC, BCA, CAB, CBA, all give the same result: Pass with merit.
