| Task 1 Candidate photo | | | Rationale |
|------------------------------|-----|---|---|
| 1 | 2.2 | 2 | Ali uses some of the language of the level, but the range is limited. |
| 2 | 3.1 | 2 | Information provided is not effectively delivered and this criterion is achieved only with examiner support. |
| 3 | 3.2 | 3 | The beach is described, as is jewelry, and Ali uses adjectives and gives explanations reasonably well. |
| 4 | 4.2 | 2 | Although views were expressed, they are not clear and are dependent on examiner support. |
| Task 2 Examiner photo | | | Rationale |
| 5 | 1.1 | 4 | Ali easily follows the gist of the conversation apart from one occasion. |
| 6 | 1.2 | 3 | There are several instances when Ali does not obtain necessary information, e.g. cost, but he copes reasonably well. |
| 7 | 2.1 | 3 | Ali's pronunciation is comprehensible but lacks a range of intonation. |
| 8 | 4.1 | 3 | Ali makes appropriate & relevant contributions, e.g. "what will you wear?", and needs only occasional support. |
| 9 | 4.3 | 3 | Despite a misunderstanding and a lack of request for information, Ali obtains specific information and shows interest. |
| Task 3: Roleplay | | | Rationale |
| 10 | 1.2 | 4 | He easily obtains the information and, in his one misunderstanding, he asks for clarification. |
| 11 | 2.1 | 3 | Although Ali copes reasonably well with pronunciation, there are some inarticulate sounds and lack of intonation. |
| 12 | 2.2 | 2 | There is a lack of range and accuracy. |
| 13 | 3.1 | 2 | The information provided is limited and he needs support, although he listens and responds well. |
| 14 | 4.3 | 4 | Ali obtains information with ease and confidence and needs no support. |

| Task 4: Group discussion | | | Rationale |

| 15 | 1.1 | 4 | He follows gist easily, responding to and asking questions throughout the discussion. |
| 16 | 3.2 | 3 | He gives short descriptions and conveys information reasonably well for the level. |
| 17 | 4.1 | 4 | Ali is able to get his message across clearly. His contributions are appropriate and asks several questions to move the conversation forward. |
| 18 | 4.2 | 3 | He expresses his views reasonably well, without using a wide range of language and functions, but shows no real signs of difficulty in getting his message across. |

| 19 | 1.3 | 4 | Ali follows instructions without difficulty. |

Total marks for Ali: 58. As well as achieving more than 50/76 to pass, he has also achieved more than 2 for every assessment criterion, and would pass at Entry 2.
