1	2.1	3	Although Deyse has good stress and intonation, some of her pronunciation is unclear, which impedes communication.
2	2.2	3	Although she uses a range of language with ease, this is not consistent.
3	3.1	4	She presents information with ease and confidence and continues a structured narrative, even with interruption.
4	3.2	4	Deyse uses creative and suitable lexis for the situation.
5	3.3	4	She conveys relevant and specific information on her topic and responds confidently and with ease.

6	1.1	4	Deyse is fully engaged with the examiner's problem and follows all aspects of the discussion.
7	1.2	3	She copes reasonably well but does need examiner support to fully understand the situation.
8	2.1	4	Her pronunciation is clear and expresses the empathy she feels for the situation.
9	4.1	3	Deyse communicates reasonably well. Her contributions are relevant but do not demonstrate a wide range of functions of the level.
10	4.2	4	She expresses her views with confidence and requires no support.
11	4.4	2	Although she achieves the communicative aim, she obtains information at a minimum level and could have asked more questions to understand the situation more fully.

12	1.2	4	She appears to fully understand the situation and additional problems given to her with ease.
13	2.2	4	The language and formality is appropriate for the context and she communicates with ease and confidence.
14	3.2	4	She gives a good verbal account of the problem using suitable lexis for the situation.
15	4.3	4	She makes some suggestions of her own to resolve the situation and plans positive action with ease and confidence.
16	4.4	3	She communicates reasonably well for the level but could have sought more detailed information.
