1.1	Plan text for the intended audience	2	There is evidence of a plan relating to task 1. The plan is appropriate, but not sufficiently detailed.	
Task	1 – form			
2.1	Produce content for the intended audience	2	The candidate produces content that is relevant for the task and the register is appropriate for both the task and intended audience. However, attempts to use complex sentences are mostly unsuccessful and as a result the communicative purpose of the task is only partially achieved.	
2.5	Use punctuation correctly	2	The candidate demonstrates poor control over the use of basic punctuation. Overuse of full stops causes difficulties.	
2.6	Spell words correctly	2	The candidate uses a range of common and special-interest vocabulary appropriately. However, spelling errors are frequent and at times impede understanding.	
3.1	Complete a form with open and closed responses correctly	3	The candidate completes most of the form appropriately and achieves its main communicative aim.

2.1	Produce content for the intended audience	4	The candidate's description of the day out with family is entirely appropriate and includes appropriate level of detail. The format and register are appropriate for the task and audience.	
2.2	Structure main points in short paragraphs	3	The article is structured appropriately into paragraphs. The structure of the paragraphs is fairly consistent.	
2.3	Sequence text chronologically	3	The candidate sequenced the text chronologically. However, the use of discourse markers and conjunctions is rather limited.	
2.4	Use grammar correctly	2	The candidate demonstrates good control over sentence structure in a range of simple sentences. However, attempts to produce complex sentences are unsuccessful.	
2.5	Use punctuation correctly	4	The candidate uses a range of punctuation for various purposes correctly, including exclamation marks and colons. Shows range with use of an exclamation mark.	
2.6	Spell words correctly	4	The candidate uses a range of vocabulary appropriately. Spelling errors do not impede communication.

2.1	Produce content for the intended audience	1	The candidate addresses both parts of the task at minimum level, using appropriate format and register. The structures used are basic.	
2.4	Use grammar correctly	1	The candidate produces only simple sentences and these are sometimes incorrect or incomplete. There are no attempts to use complex sentences.	
2.5	Use punctuation correctly	3	The candidate uses a range of punctuation mostly appropriately for the purpose, including exclamation marks.

1.1	Plan text for the intended audience	4	The candidate has two tasks planned with some level of detail.	
Task	1 – form			
2.1	Produce content for the intended audience	4	The form is completed appropriately, all the sub tasks have been addressed (skills, experience, education). The style and register are appropriately answered.	
2.5	Use punctuation correctly	4	The candidate uses full stop and commas with consistency and shows comprehensive control.	
2.6	Spell words correctly	4	A good range of vocabulary is used and spelling is mostly accurate. The candidate demonstrates a comprehensive control of the level.	
3.1	Complete a form with open and closed responses correctly	4	The form has been completed effectively and all communication aims are achieved.	
Task	2 – article			
2.1	Produce content for the intended audience	4	The candidate shows an effective description of a trip to Gower. Furthermore all three sub tasks have been addressed with good expansion.	
2.2	Structure main points in short paragraphs	3	Paragraphs used throughout by the candidate but some are rather short (1 sentence). There is an intro and also development, but no conclusion.	
2.3	Sequence text chronologically	4	The candidate demonstrates a consistency and comprehensive control. The passage is very well structured and there is an effective use of devices: ' <i>Firstly</i> ', ' <i>After that</i> '	
2.4	Use grammar correctly	3	Complex and compound sentences are used accurately in the text eg, 'we rented mini buses which are not expensive'. Grammar use is fairly consistent and errors exist but do not impede.	
2.5	Use punctuation correctly	4	The candidate shows an effective use of punctuation, which includes commas. Consistency with punctuation is shown.	
2.6	Spell words correctly	4	A good comprehensive range and control of vocabulary is demonstrated in the text. The spelling is very accurate.

Task	Task 3 – message, email or letter			
2.1	Produce content for the intended audience	2	The register and format are appropriate for the task. Some parts of the task were not fully developed, which is reflected by the short response.	
2.4	Use grammar correctly	2	There was no attempt to use any complex sentences and therefore there is a lack of linkers, conjunctions etc. Very simple structures are present throughout the text.	
2.5	Use punctuation correctly	2	The candidate's use of end of sentence punctuation and capitalisation is inconsistent.	

Candidate 2 achieves 48 marks out of 56 and passes the Writing exam.
