CE	4	Jose fulfils the task very well by initiating and responding with effective turn-taking. In the discussion of the presentation, he clarifies very well what he means as regards adults learning lexis when this point is queried by the examiner. In general, he contributes to a very natural, high level discussion. He appropriately challenges the examiner's viewpoint in the collaborative and in the Topic discussion tasks and the following conversation tries to establish common ground in the discussion. This is a sophisticated performance of communicative effectiveness.
IL	4	Jose understands all interventions, and interprets all examiner aims and attitudes accurately following the line of argument, including those that are nuanced and more complex to process. He is able to respond immediately to the examiner's interventions that are complex grammatically and in ideas. His responses are always appropriate and to the point without prevarication or hesitation.
LC	4	A very wide range is demonstrated and an extremely high level of accuracy is maintained throughout the whole exam. Jose uses complex grammatical items and lexis in a fully appropriate and effortless manner. Frequent examples of appropriate phrases / collocations e.g. 'it's important to bear in mind'. Slips are barely noticeable.
D	4	Jose is clearly intelligible and is very effective in using intonation and focal stress. He speaks effortlessly and fluently, and although there is some pausing, this is to collect his thoughts rather than search for language. No careful listening is required at all.
IND LIST	4	Jose's summary of the general meaning of the text is excellent. Although it cannot be said that he mentions everything which is in the text (difficult as the text is more than twice the length of time that the candidate has to answer in), it is hard to imagine what more he could say. All important points are covered and the attitude and purpose are identified as well as can be expected.
