Preparing for the session skills part of the exam helps to develop improvisation and playback skills. Songs have been carefully chosen to help students develop specific skills such as rhythmic control in Aloe Blacc's song 'I Need a Dollar' or improvising in 'Without You' by Mariah Carey.
