Trinity's ESOL Step 1 and Step 2 Speaking and Listening awards are for adults aged 16 and over who have started to learn English but are not yet ready to take an Entry level qualification. These awards provide students with the opportunity to mark learning progression while they build up the skills and confidence needed to take ESOL Skills for Life qualifications.

Demonstrating basic skills

Candidates who have achieved a Step 1 or Step 2 award can:

- Understand what is said clearly, slowly and directly in simple everyday conversation with support
- Communicate simple information on familiar matters
- Use basic sentence patterns and simple phrases about themselves, places and other people

Full details of the language requirements for each level are available online.

Assessment format

The format for Step 1 and Step 2 exams is an unscripted one-to-one conversation with a Trinity examiner.

The examiner uses pictures, objects and references to surroundings to engage and prompt candidates to demonstrate their English language communication skills by listening and responding to the examiner's questions verbally and through gestures and simple actions.


