The Trinity Certificate for Practising Teachers (CertPT) promotes the acquisition and refinement of specialist skills needed to develop and use effective teaching resources with professional insight.

- ▶ Evaluate, adapt, create and reflect on the use of teaching resources, informed by professional knowledge and insight
- ▶ Bilingual training and assessment options
- ▶ 30 minimum GLH** + 70 hours' self-study

TYLEC

The Trinity Teaching Young Learners Extension Certificate (TYLEC) is designed to equip English language teachers with the specialist knowledge and skills they need to teach young learners aged 7-12 years.

- ▶ Face-to-face, online or blended options

- ▶ Includes classroom management, use of contextual resources, lesson planning, and theory as it relates to teaching young learners
- ▶ 58 minimum GLH** + 42 hours' self-study
