By train from Leeds train station

- Exit Leeds train station from Exit 2 City Square.
- As you come out of the station, go to the crossing in front of you. Cross Wellington Street and walk and turn to the right onto Quebec Street.
- Turn left on Quebec Street and follow the road north and you will find 14 King Street, a brown building on the corner on the right.
- ▶ The entrance to the exam centre is on Toronto Street which is accessed from Quebec Street.
- Walk through the black gates and you will see the entrance on your left.



By bus

- Several different bus services stop near to be Leeds SELT Centre.
- City Square has bus stops A C which service the St James, Birstall, Pudsey and Heckmonwike lines.
