### Context (max 150 words)

Katy is a learning disabled adult who attends a number of different weekly Electric Umbrella sessions where she creates and performs music and takes part in musical workshops alongside other learning disabled adults and professional musicians. During a 'Pushing Boundaries''session, we undertook a number of different musical activities, including moving/dancing to different music, to express how it makes us feel, playing 'happy/sad, thumbs up/down''to note the difference between musical styles, keys and modes and responding to the structural elements of instrumental versions of songs. Katy has short brown hair and is wearing black trousers, a black hoodie over a yellow t-shirt and white trainers.

### Observation (max 150 words)

"Dancefloor" video - when hearing the start of Bob Marley, Katy said, "I love reggae", moving
with a laid back bounce (00:05). She began to sway lyrically to the waltz (01:21) and her
movements changed to a rhythmic "march" when "Sweet Child of Mine" playe d, with her hands
pulsing in time (02:52). Her hands sped up, matching the beat of "Backbone" (03:30) before
returning to a rhythmic sway (and singing) to the instrumental of "You gotta friend in me"
(04:23) When the group performed "Stand by Me" Katy star ted the vocal at the appropriate
time, without any need for prompt or conductor (Stand by Me video). Katy was smiley when
dancing to Bob Marley and Guns n Roses. However, when a prolonged minor chord was played
on the piano, Katy held up her "sad face" to show how it made her feel (minor chord video)

### Interpretation (max 150 words)

Katy is able to recognise structural elements of music, anticipating and responding to them effectively (knowing when to start the vocal line of "Stand by Me"). She recognises and responds to different musical genres, keys, modes, metres and rhythms, as shown by her different dancing/movement styles and facial expressions in response to different types of music.

### Observation (max 150 words)

Katy performed "Flowers" with confidence and delivered the lyrics, pitch and rhythm fluently.
Towards the end of the first verse, when a phrase went lower than she would like, Katy
improvised and adapted the melody so that it went into a more comfortable p art of her vocal
range. This showed good musical instincts and an understanding of her own pitch and vocal
capabilities. She dealt with the syncopation in the chorus well and stayed with the beat
throughout (flowers video). When Katy sang the EU Song, she was able to lead the vocal
without any conductor, she varied the phrases to create new motifs, always adhering to the
key, rhythm and tempo of the song (EU Song video)

### Interpretation (max 150 words)

Katy can confidently perform songs that are at least Grade 1 Level, with consistency of pitch, tone and rhythm. Her intonation and melodic line are good and she understands how to project her voice effectively. With the EU Song, Katy showed that she unders tands the structural and harmonic elements of the song, allowing her to improvise new variations of the "call" phrases and experiment with different styles of vocal production and projection.

She acted as lead vocalist for the group, singing throughout the performance.

### Observation (max 150 words)

Katy sang confidently and fluently throughout the performance. She did not need a conductor to cue her for any entries as she clearly understood the structure of the piece and her role within the ensemble. Her pitch, lyric delivery and rhythm were good thr oughout and she adapted her vocal line to more comfortable octave ranges where necessary, still understanding and adhering to the melodic line.		

### Interpretation (max 150 words)

Katy can confidently perform as part of an ensemble, understanding her role within the group, listening to the other instruments and delivering her role as lead vocalist consistently throughout. Stand by Me is, I believe, of Grade 1 standard.
