Award levels and performance duration

Select the appropriate award based on learners' abilities and developmental milestones:

Bronze Award



Performance length:
5–8 minutes

Focus: Teacher-guided. Promotes early participation and confidence-building.

Silver Award



Performance length:
8–12 minutes

Focus: Children take more ownership. Encourages teamwork and confidence.

Gold Award



Performance length:
12–15 minutes

Focus: Minimal teacher support. Builds creative expression and independence.

How it works and next steps

- 1 Teachers select familiar classroom material (songs, stories, or rhymes) suited to their group.
- 2 Children prepare a group performance.
- 3 Submission options:
 - Filmed performance and uploaded online
 - In-class performance with a visit from a Trinity expert
 - Receive written feedback from Trinity expert, along with medals and certificates for every child.
