Our exams centre on performance and encourage individuality with options that include original songs and self-accompanied performance. Useful resources are available online, including video tutorials, as well as professional development support for music teachers.



Who are they for?

Our Rock & Pop exams are for students of any age and any level, whether they are self-taught or taking lessons. They are also an excellent resource for classroom lessons or after-school music courses.

What will students get out of our Rock & Pop exams?

Rock & Pop students will build confidence in playing and performance and gain practical skills and techniques through performing a set of songs and a Session skill (Improvising or Playback). Students will learn about the context of the music and the artists that wrote it, as well as about songwriting, playing in bands and music copyright. Rock & Pop students will gain recognition for their skills through fully accredited qualifications which also carry UCAS points at Grades 6-8.
