Performance is at the core of our Rock & Pop qualifications for vocals, reflecting the way singers learn today.

Whether they are self-taught or taking lessons, learning for fun or heading for a career in the music industry, these exams will help singers develop valuable singing skills and achieve their musical ambitions.

With graded song lists spanning a range of artists including Justin Timberlake, Beyoncé and Michael Bublé, singers can learn and have their achievements formally recognised while learning the music they love.

Songs have been carefully selected to help students develop specific skills such as rhythmic control in Aloe Blacc's song 'I Need a Dollar' or improvising in 'Without You' by Mariah Carey. Session skills help to develop improvisation and playback skills.

In the exam, students perform three songs and complete one of the two session skills. With options to include an original song and to perform unaccompanied or self-accompanied, singers can make the exam their own and show off their individual talent.
