
THE SONGBOOKS

You can access everything you need to prepare for the performance part of the exam in our graded songbooks. Our Rock & Pop books are available for Initial to Grade 8 and each includes eight songs with performance hints and tips. There's also useful background information so you can explore the story behind, and techniques used in, the songs.

BE PART OF THE BAND

Each song comes with a demo and backing track recorded by top industry session musicians, produced professionally in a recording studio. Practise wherever suits you by downloading the track to your phone, tablet or computer.





REAL SKILLS.

You'll play a set list of three tracks in your exam, chosen from our song lists. Each song has been specially arranged for the grade so you can prove your level of technique and musicianship through your exam performance.

MAKE THE EXAM YOUR OWN

You can personalise your set list to demonstrate your individuality and creativity. If there's a song you love that's not on our song lists you have the option of performing it as your second song, or you can pick from a range of songs made available from the previous syllabus. You can showcase your songwriting skills by choosing to perform a song you've written, and you can accompany yourself, or be accompanied by another musician.

The third song you'll play is a technical focus song, chosen from the songbook for the grade. This song focuses on two specific technical skills which run throughout the song, so you can demonstrate these techniques seamlessly in your performance. You're able to get more marks for your performance of this song.

BASS



Our Bass exams introduce you to the right skills at the right time, developing the important techniques you need at each grade. Beginning with basic positions, picking and damping techniques, you'll then move on to slapped and pulled notes, bends and slides, and harmonics.

You can explore syncopation in Coldplay's 'Yellow', palm muting using the pick in Paramore's 'Misery Business', and fast articulation in Queens of the Stone Age's 'No One Knows'.

DRUMS

Rock & Pop Drums exams take you through key playing skills step-by-step, beginning with basic grooves in a range of styles with different time signatures, tempos and strokes, solo breaks and fills, and moving on to instrumental techniques including paradiddles, flams, drags, ruffs, rim shots and ratamacues.

You can learn about trashy hi hat in Blur's 'Song 2', time changes in 'Alive' by Pearl Jam, and syncopation and swinging in Joe Cocker's 'With a Little Help from My Friends'.



GUITAR



Our Guitar exams help you build up your playing skills as you move through the grades. Starting with basic chords and positions, picking and damping, you'll then move on to hammer-ons and pull-offs, bends, slides and harmonics.

You can explore picking precision in 'I Can't Explain' by The Who, riff playing and bends in The Beatles' 'Day Tripper', and rapid picking and octaves in Foo Fighters' 'Rope'.

KEYBOARDS

Rock & Pop Keyboards exams help you develop the techniques you need at each grade, introducing you to key skills step-by-step. You'll begin with common chords, simple melodies, and rhythms in different styles and keys, moving on to pedalling techniques, scales passages, improvising and more complex chords.

You can learn about swing rhythm in 'Gold on the Ceiling' by The Black Keys, octave leaps in Sia's 'Chandelier', and the use of the sustain pedal with Pink Floyd's 'The Great Gig in the Sky'.





VOCALS



Our Rock & Pop Vocals exams help you build up your singing skills as you move through the grades. Starting with singing in different styles and registers, improving your sound and widening your range, you'll then move on to developing techniques such as decorating and improvising.

You can explore pick-ups and belting skills in 'Just Looking' by Stereophonics, diction and pitching in Dusty Springfield's 'Son of a Preacher Man', and vocal agility and rapping in Taylor Swift's 'Shake It Off'.
