## Music diploma exams

For musicians looking to take their professional development to the next level.

### Performance diplomas:

- Focus on the planning and performance of a recital, with no supporting tests
- Allow candidates to compile a personalised programme according to their own strengths and interests, with no set number of pieces, and the freedom to select items from published lists or pieces of their own choice
- Enable candidates to gain marks for programme planning, presentation and stagecraft

### Teaching diplomas:

- Examine instrumental and vocal teaching to individuals and groups
- Cover a range of theoretical and practical components

### Theory diplomas – AMusTCL and LMusTCL:

- Develop a broad understanding of theoretical and analytical concepts and procedures, as well as a wide-ranging knowledge of Western classical music history

Trinity's diplomas are included on the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF) at the following levels:

Diploma	RQF	Equivalent standard
Associate (ATCL or AMusTCL)	Level 4	First year of an undergraduate degree course
Licentiate (LTCL or LMusTCL)	Level 6	Final year of undergraduate degree course
Fellowship (FTCL)	Level 7	Master's level course
