

Trinity SELT Centre Newcastle

**Floor 2 (Regus), Rotterdam House, 116
Quayside, Newcastle, NE1 3DY**

Rotterdam house is a large glass fronted building located in the Quayside area of Newcastle. The test centre is on Floor 2 (Regus). When you come into the building, turn right towards the lifts and press 2 (Regus Reception). Exit the lift on Floor 2 and head straight ahead towards the reception area, where Trinity staff will welcome you to the centre.

ACCESSIBILITY

The centre is fully accessible with step free access throughout and accessible toilet facilities on Floor 2.

GETTING THERE:



By train from Newcastle Central Station

- ▶ Exit Newcastle Central Station through the main front doors onto Neville Street and turn right.
- ▶ Walk for about 1 minute, then turn left onto Collingwood Street.
- ▶ Continue straight downhill (the street becomes St Nicholas Street) and pass St Nicholas' Cathedral on your left.
- ▶ At the bottom, cross the road towards the Swing Bridge, then turn left onto The Side and follow it downhill to the Quayside.
- ▶ Turn left on the Quayside and walk for 2-3 minutes – 116 Quayside will be on your left, near the Law Courts.



By bus

- ▶ Buses are available outside Newcastle Central station, on Grainger Street and City Road (A 3 minute walk from the exam centre)
- ▶ The nearest stop to the exam centre is City Road.

By car

- ▶ Exit onto the A184 toward Gateshead/Newcastle (Centre), follow signs into Newcastle over the Redheugh Bridge, then stay left and follow signs for the Quayside.
- ▶ Continue onto St James' Boulevard (A189), take the second exit at the large roundabout, then turn right at the lights onto Westgate Road (A186). Follow the road downhill as it becomes Collingwood Street and then St Nicholas Street.
- ▶ Pass St Nicholas' Cathedral, follow signs for Quayside/Swing Bridge, bear left onto The Side, then turn left at the bottom onto Quayside. Continue ~300m and Regus (116 Quayside) is on the left just before the Law Court.



Parking

Trinity College London has no parking facilities. However, nearby car park facilities are:
